AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Second Clarinet:

Concerto of choice (an excerpt approximate 3 minutes in length)

First Clarinet excerpts:

Beethoven: *Symphony No. 6*, mvt I (mm 147-150 & 474-492), mvt II (mm 68-77)

Beethoven: *Symphony No. 8*, mvt III (mm 4-35)

Gershwin: *Rhapsody in Blue* (opening solo)

Prokofiev: *Peter and the Wolf* (solo at reh 20)

Rimsky-Korsakov: *Capriccio Espagnol*, mvt III (mm 51-end)

Second Clarinet excerpts (be prepared to play along with the Principal Clarinetist in the final round):

Berlioz: *Symphonie Fantastique*, mvt V (5th bar of reh 62 — reh 63)

Dvorak: *Symphony No. 8*, mvt II (mm 12-28)

Mendelssohn: *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, Scherzo (mm 1-48)

Tchaikovsky: *Symphony No. 5*, mvt I (mm 1-37)

Possible Sight Reading

Principal Trombone:

Solo or Concerto of choice (an excerpt approximate 3 minutes in length)

First Trombone excerpts:

Berlioz: *Damnation of Faust* (Hungarian March)

Brahms: *Symphony No. 1*, mvt IV (reh C — Allegro)

Mozart: *Requiem* (Tuba Mirum)

Ravel: *Bolero* (solo)

Respighi: *Pines of Rome*, mvt II (7 before reh 11 — 11 after reh 12)

Schumann: *Symphony No. 3*, mvt IV (mm 1-23)

Saint-Saens: *Symphony No. 3*, mvt I (reh Q — reh S)

Wagner: *Die Walkure* (B major excerpt)
